

Make sure Bluetooth is "On" on your smartphone. 2. Press and hold the "Pairing" button until LED is blue and blinking. 3. Check for "POP Multimedia" on the list of detected devices. 4. Select "POP Multimedia" and wait for the pop up menu. 5. Tap the "Pair" button on the pop up menu. <p style="text-align: center;">5</p>
<p>Using Multimedia Functions</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open native audio or video apps 2. Press the Satechi Bluetooth Media Button to play/pause. 3. Adjust volume and skip tracks <p>Deleting and Re-Pairing Your Media Button</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Press the "pairing" button on your Satechi Bluetooth Media Button using a thin long tool till the blue LED light turns on. 2. Press and hold the "pairing" button longer than 3 seconds till blue LED light blinks.
